

Work on the undergraduate supervision system: Lent Term 2025 progress report

This progress report follows [those regularly made since Michaelmas Term 2023](#). It summarises the work conducted regarding the undergraduate supervision system, as part of the University's and Colleges' [Teaching Review](#) and the "Justice for College Supervisors" (J4CS) campaign.

- Recommendations from the Teaching Review Steering Group are currently being finalised, a draft set of recommendations have been circulated to Colleges and will be considered by the General Board's Education Committee at its meeting on 9 April 2025. It is expected that the finalised recommendations will be presented to the University Council for approval in Easter Term 2025.
- One recommendation from the Teaching Review will be to provide greater resources for Directors of Studies and supervisors, to encourage innovation, support good practice and reduce administrative burden. A SharePoint site is currently being developed by the Colleges' Office of Intercollegiate Services and the University's Education Quality and Policy Office, it is hoped that this new site will be launched in Easter Term 2025.
- Following discussions between the J4CS campaigners and Collegiate representatives, regular meetings have been paused by mutual agreement.
- Further work on releasing a second report on [the supervisor workload survey](#) held in 2024 has been delayed.
